OUTDOOR BOWLS LOOKS FORWARD TO 2026

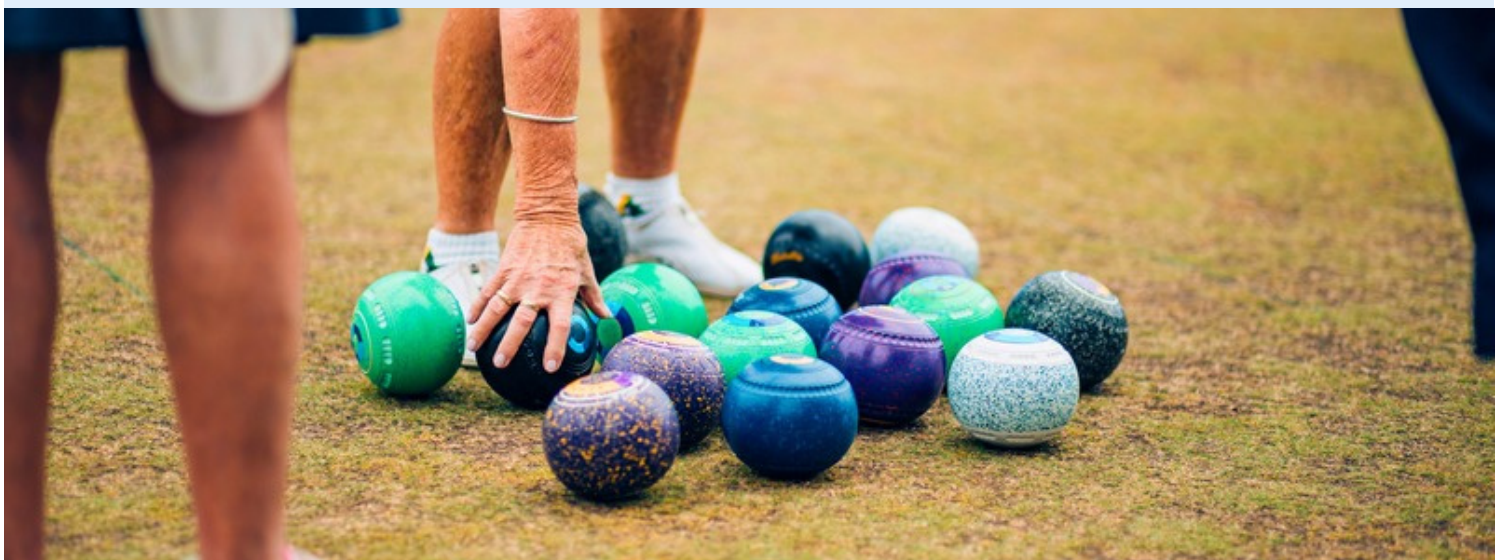

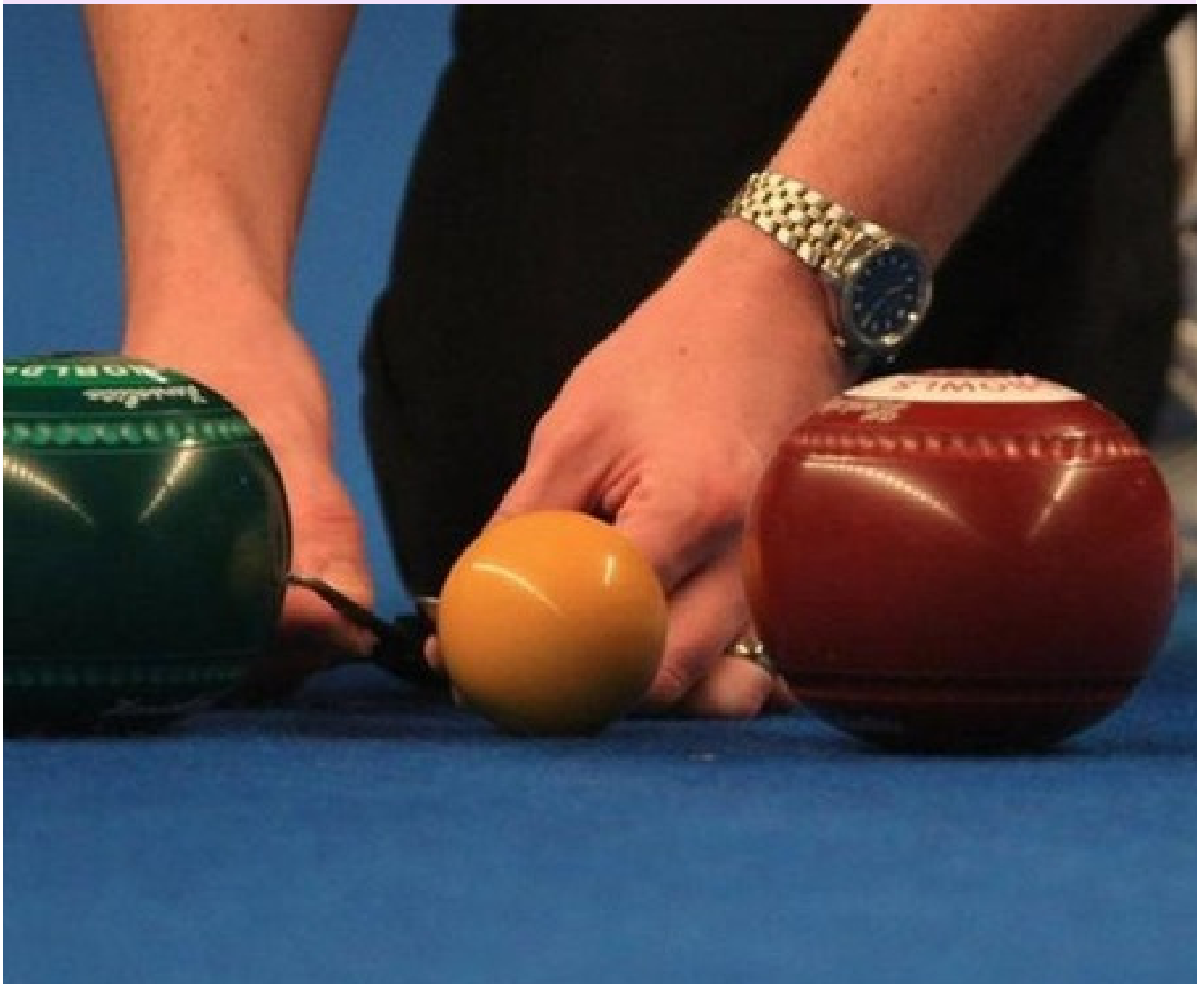


INDOOR BOWLS: BACK IN FEBRUARY 2026

Heath Woollett won the CCCCCDA 1st Division singles trophy, seen here receiving his trophy at the CCCCCDA presentation night in November.

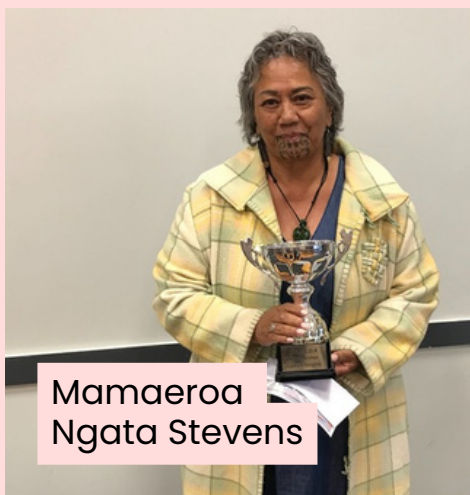

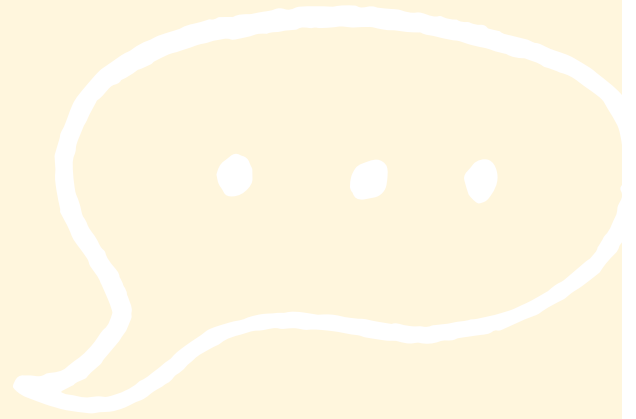
